Dues

Please refer to the attached dues payment form for the amount of yearly dues. Our objective for 2017 is 120 residential dues, 50 lots and all the rental dues.

Finances

Annual dues for 2016-2017 – we received 106 payments for an amount of \$6,354.54 and donations totaling \$495.00. Regarding the dam fund, we collected \$3,585.06 for a total of \$6,729.06. As of March 31, 2017, our banked funds totaled \$18,914.32.

Dams on Lac des Pins

Since 2013 Board members have been working hard on the sectoral taxation project with the municipality. This tax will serve to pay the cost of studies, appraisals, plans and specifications, as well as the implementation of the works. We must ensure our conformity with the safety standards for our two dams, as required by the Centre d'Expertise Hydrique du Québec (CEHQ). In June 2016, the statutory inspection was carried out by Mr. Chum, Eng.

During a special general meeting held on April 18, 2017, the Board presented the loan bylaw project and a resolution allowing the members of the Board to negotiate its financing and reimbursement. After responding to questions from the members, the assembly voted unanimously in favour of the proposition.

At the request of the municipality, on April 27, the Board submitted an environmental evaluation and a management framework (carried out by biologist Mathieu Madison of the firm Gestion Environnement MM). The Board is also drafting a Memorandum of Understanding for the loan bylaw. In principle the loan bylaw should be adopted in June.

In July, an engineer will study security issues with the dams, set up an emergency measures plan, prepare a management plan for the stored water and transmit the studies to the CEHQ. Following this, he will prepare recommendations regarding the work to be prioritized.

Quality of Lake Water

Once again our swimming water is rated "A" ("excellent"). The bacteriological analysis was performed in the summer of 2016 by Laboratoire Bio-Services (certified by the Ministère du Développement durable, de l'Environnement et de Lutte contre les changements climatiques (MDDELCC)).

Respect for the Environment

Once again this year, we request that you keep the beach and association clean and in good condition so we can all enjoy the great environment offered by the Alpine Estates. **Please act responsibly!**
